2025 Inside Out International Finance Forum Submission Guidelines and Requirements

IMPORTANT: This document serves as a guide to help you through the application process. Please note that all applications must be submitted via <u>FilmFreeway</u>.

Eligibility Criteria

We are looking for queer, market-ready projects with both producer and director attached, seeking financing opportunities.

Priority will be given to projects with 2SLGBTQ+ identified key creatives (ie. writer and/or director) and teams. Co-productions with Canada are encouraged to apply, including those seeking a Canadian producer.

Projects submitted to a previous edition, excluding 2024, are eligible to participate in 2025 if significant changes to the creative and/or packaging of the project can be demonstrated. Please let Inside Out's IFF 2025 team know ahead of time that you will be submitting a project from a previous edition. Producers and creators who have participated in previous editions are welcomed to submit new projects.

Non-English language projects must provide a translated script and materials as part of the submission package.

Please combine all submission materials into a single PDF file and upload it to the 'Script' section in FilmFreeway, except for the Pitch Deck. The Pitch Deck should be uploaded separately under the 'Files & Attachments' section.

ALL PROJECT SUBMISSIONS MUST INCLUDE THE REQUESTED INFORMATION LISTED ABOVE. Incomplete submissions will not be evaluated.

Applicants submitting projects that support, reflect, and strengthen diversity are expected to tangibly demonstrate a genuine and sustained commitment to these equity-seeking communities. Inside Out's International Finance Forum encourages applications from companies that are BIPOC led, as well as applications from people with disabilities and people who have barriers to accessing technology.
