

RE:Focus Fund.

Inside Out's RE:Focus Fund, established in 2018 with a lead gift from Martha McCain, addresses industry inequities by providing direct financial support to women, non-binary, and trans filmmakers telling 2SLGBTQ+ stories.

To date, the fund has distributed over \$300,000 in festival travel grants, professional development programs, and post-production grants, which were introduced in 2019 to support the completion and promotion of films.

In 2024, the fund had its most impactful year yet, awarding more funds than ever before, empowering underrepresented filmmakers, and advancing diversity in queer storytelling thanks to the continued generosity of our community. Below are the 2024 RE:Focus Fund grant recipients.






As a proud and continued partner of the Toronto International Film Festival, Inside Out was thrilled to share space with TIFF once again this year.




